Keiser University to Sponsor South Fork High School's Popular SAT "Word of the Day" Project

Stuart, Florida—September 4, 2008— For the 3rd consecutive year, Keiser University is proud to partner with South Fork High School as a sponsor of the "Word of the Day" Project preparing students for the SAT by exposing them to vocabulary words in an exciting game/contest format.

South Fork High School TV Production class students set up a daily program that introduces and creatively shows the meaning and context of words taken from SAT vocabulary reviews. In addition, Keiser University's Computer Graphics and Design students create posters for each word which are mounted at the hallway entrances and exits throughout the campus. Tickets are distributed to teachers who volunteer at the start of the year to be "Secret Teachers." The first student to say the word of the day and its meaning to the secret teacher receives the ticket which places his/her name in a drawing each marking period.

As a sponsor of the Word of the Day Project, Keiser University Community Relations Coordinator John Bowman will highlight each marking period's "Word of the Day" winner on the morning announcements and present the student with a Keiser University T-shirt, IPOD and a gift basket.
