INSTRUCTIONS

You must submit the following along with your signed application:

- Two letters of recommendation from teachers, employers, counselors, or a community service organization in which you have participated or are participating.
- An official transcript stamped with your school's seal, reflecting seven consecutive semesters of high school and a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. ***Photocopies will not be accepted.***
- GED students must show proof of attendance and a passing grade in the GED program.
- Students must be enrolled in Keiser University-Lakeland and have paid the application fee of \$55 in order to apply for the scholarship.
- An essay containing a minimum of 250 words describing a significant experience that led you to pursue an education at Keiser University. This may be typed or handwritten but must be on standard 8 ½ x 11 sized paper and must have your name, address, and high school name printed in the upper left hand corner. It must be signed by you below a statement indicating that it was written by you without assistance from another person.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- This scholarship is awarded by Keiser University-Lakeland to four selected high school students who are enrolled in the college. This scholarship is not transferable to another institution. There is no cash value on the awarded scholarships.
- Scholarships are available to students who have a minimum 2.0 GPA (on a 4 point grading scale) in high school. Awards are merit-based and will be judged on the applicant's GPA, two letters of recommendation, and a 250 word essay.
- Scholarships are available to students who will meet Florida's high school graduation requirements for the 2006-2007 school year and to students receiving a GED between the dates of January 1, 2007 and July 25, 2007.
- Each student may submit only one application for the Keiser University-Lakeland scholarship.
- **A COMPLETE APPLICATION PACKAGE, INCLUDING TRANSCRIPT, APPLICATION FORM, 2 LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION, AND ESSAY MUST BE POSTMARKED OR BROUGHT TO KEISER UNIVERSITY-LAKELAND BY JULY 31, 2007.**
- Keiser University's campus administration will select the scholarship recipient of each scholarship award. All decisions are final.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by letter by August 10, 2007.
- The scholarship recipients must start class at Keiser University-Lakeland in the fall term of 2007.
- Each student must meet all of the admission requirements of Keiser University. Students are encouraged to review the admission requirements of the institution to which they are applying to ensure they meet the admissions requirements and understand the details of the scholarship.
- This scholarship can be used towards any program offered at Keiser University-Lakeland except the Radiologic Technology, Nuclear Medicine, and Nursing programs.
