

**CACREP Vital Statistics Report  
2023-2024 Academic Year**

In compliance with the Council for the Accreditation for Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) the following vital statistics are available for students enrolled in the Master of Science (MS) in Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CMHC) program at Keiser University:

Data Notes:

- The reporting period reflects data for the academic year starting July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.
- The degree completion rate is based on the percentage of students completing the 60-hour MS degree program within 150% of the expected three-year timeline.
- Licensure/certification exam pass rates and job placement rates are based on self-disclosed reporting figures from 25 graduates in the 2023-2034 academic year.
- Twenty-two of the 25 graduates self-disclosed that they sat for and passed the exam (88%). The remaining three have not yet sat and are less than a year out from graduation.
- Twenty of the 25 graduates were deemed eligible for job placement. Of these 20, all were placed for 100% reporting.
- The five graduates deemed ineligible for job placement are pending licensure. This includes two registered mental health counselor interns (RMHCI) who have passed the exam but have not yet completed supervised hours for licensure; and three who have not yet sat for the exam.
